Artist Spotlight: Pat Hutchinson

Pat Hutchinson received her MFA from Penn State University and taught art and design at The College of New Jersey and Ocean, Mercer and Brookdale Community Colleges.



Like Being Alone

Invited to teach a design class in the Technological Studies Department of The College of New Jersey, she became interested in the creative process as envisioned by practical designers in the "built environment." Subsequently, she completed a Ph.D. in Design and Technology Education at New York University, carrying out research on British Design and Technology Education while on a Fulbright Scholarship at Oxford, UK. After finishing her doctorate, she co-founded *TIES Magazine* at Drexel University, Philadelphia, a design education publication for teachers, and served as director and curriculum coordinator for two National Science Foundation projects.



Green Dancer While pursuing her career in education, Hutchinson continued to paint and show her work. She is most interested in the figure and she has focused on dancers and other performers throughout much of her career. She is a co-founder, past board member and past chair of the Belmar Arts Council and served on the board of the Algonquin Theatre in Manasquan, NJ for six years.

Over the past two years, a growing interest in social justice issues has inspired her to develop a series of large paintings she calls "Look Me in the Eye," featuring portraits of a diverse group of Americans whose images confront us visually. Since 2016, she has also organized and curated several activist art exhibitions in Central New Jersey.
